FUNCTIONAL PROGRAM

To vehicle the integration of this nowadays so isolated piece of town a mixed-use program is proposed. To highlight this segment of the long seashore promenade, within the mixed-use program a specific function is proposed.

About 70% of Barcelona's economy directly or indirectly is based upon tourism.

In the last years the number of tourists arriving by sea is constantly increasing. In terms of (cruiser) passengers Barcelona Port is the first in the Mediterranean Sea. In terms of products (containers) it is one of the great hubs of south Europe.

The busy activity of Barcelona port, in consonance with the worldwide growth of sea transport, asks for specifically trained workforces.

Nowadays sea-related higher education is split in separated curricula and universities. To concentrate them in order to exploit their synergies is the starting point of this project.

The new Sea Campus will include educational buildings, cultural facilities, leisure facilities, and related residential buildings, taking advantage of the already existing sport facilities. All together will build up a little town in itself. One of the challenges is to make this piece of town as permeable as possible.

We will focus our main attention on the college, which works like any other university, with spaces and rooms that fulfil the specific requirements related to the different study programs and that should enhance transversality of knowledge and cooperation.

The campus includes a canteen open to everybody, which together with the hotel provides internship and compulsory business practise to the students.

An interpretation centre and a specialized public library, with integrated documentation archive, complete the offer.

In close relation to the campus residential buildings will host students and teachers. Social housing will avoid gentrification of the area. These buildings should provide some smaller services run by privates.

Campus and housing area have to act as connectors between the surrounding neighbourhoods, attracting people from outside and being permeable to peoples' cross-through movements. Activities will only be successful if they extend from the interior to the contiguous public space.

The other aim in the origin of this project is the connection along the sea front: an "overall" public space, in form of a promenade or boulevard for pedestrian and bikers, will link the neighbour segments and complete the intermunicipal linear park along the coast.
